However, like many Protestant parents, the Clarks adopted some Catholic practices, such as celebrating Mass regularly, when their children were young. Richard said, "At first [our children] had to learn Catholicism, but now we've got the kids in school getting it." In one of her books, June said, "My husband and I belong to a church which is denominational, but we have reached some kind of understanding about being Christians and working together as a family." When asked about the significance of Jesus, she said, "You can talk about what a person did, or what a person said or what a person felt, but it isn

If you're working with bone, use a butcher's saw. It will have knurled, beveled teeth to hold the wood, and since it's circular, you can use it with a circular saw.
